1. Practice writing first names of friends, toys, and relatives. Your child may need to trace the letters of these names at first. Be sure to write in large print letters.



- 2. When reading stories to your child, let them make up the ending, or retell favorite stories with "silly" new endings that they make up.
- 3. **Play mystery sock.** Put a common household item in a sock. Tie off the top of the sock. Have your child feel the sock and guess what is inside. Take turns guessing what's inside.
